GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

- Students, willing to study from home with the consent of the parents may be allowed to do so.
- Follow-up on the progress of the learning outcomes of all such students may be planned appropriately.

- School bus facility is available. (Padiyottuchal to School & Velichamthode to School via Kankol.)
- Parents should ensure and educate wards not to exchange masks with others.
- Parents should ensure that they must not send their wards to school if the child or any family member living in the same house suffers from fever/cough/breathlessness etc. Similarly, children with underlying medical conditions are to take appropriate precautions as advised by their respective medical practitioners.
- Ensure that children carry safe drinking water.
- Ensure that your ward attends classes regularly, whether online or face to face, unless there is a valid reason for absence.
- Supervise your ward's education and monitor academic progress by contacting the teachers regularly.
- Ensure that your ward is properly dressed in full school uniform for attending both online and face-to-face classes.
- Please evaluate the health condition of your ward before sending them to school.
- Do not send them to school if they are sick or if they have any symptoms related to covid 19.
- Make sure your child is physically and mentally active.
- COUNSELING will be provided by the school to ensure emotional stability, removal of anxiety and building up self-confidence of children once they come back to school after a long gap.

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

- Masks must be worn by all students while traveling.
- Masks must be worn by all students during school hours.
- Masks must be worn properly to cover the mouth and nose.
- Students must bring extra masks.
- It is mandatory to wear N-95 Mask.
- Students should come to school as per allotted batch.
- All students must maintain a distance of 1 meters between themselves and teachers across the school premises.
- Handshakes / touching each other must be avoided.
- Students are encouraged to carry a sanitizer in their bags to sanitize their hands frequently.
- Students must wash their hands properly or sanitize them if their hands are visibly soiled, before eating, after using the toilet, after coughing or sneezing.

- Students coming through public transport should take all precautions .
- Self-monitoring of health by all and disclosure about any illness at the earliest to school helpline.
- Students must be well dressed in neat and clean .
- Avoid touching your face, eyes mouth and nose frequently.
- Students should not share any material (textbooks, notebooks, pen, pencil, eraser, water bottles, etc.) with each other.
